

## PRIVACY POLICY

If you use any of the services which e-Ochards provides, you will be deemed to have consented to the collection and use of the personal information you submit to e-Ochards in the ways described below. Therefore, please read this Policy with care and if you have any questions or comments, e-mail e-Ochards at [support@e-orchards.co.uk](mailto:support@e-orchards.co.uk).

1. In order for e-Ochards to provide its services to you, including (but not limited to) domain name, website hosting and eCommerce services (the "**Services**"), e-Ochards might ask you to provide it with certain personal information.
2. Any personal information collected by e-Orchards will be used e-Orchards only in accordance with current data protection legislation.
3. Such personal information will be collected and processed by e-Ochards or its agents for the following purposes:
  - (i) to provide the Services to you;
  - (ii) administration; and
  - (iii) marketing, advertising and promotions.
4. Collecting and processing your personal information for the above purposes might entail sharing the information with employees, contractors and professional advisers of e-Ochards and/or the employees, and sending you unsolicited advertising and promotional material pertaining to other e-Ochards products and services and to third party products and services selected by E-Ochards. Where information is collected from you will be given the opportunity to inform e-Ochards that you do not wish to receive such advertising and promotional material.
5. In the event that e-Ochards is acquired, the personal information e-Ochards has collected will be considered as part of the company's assets and may, therefore, be transferred to a purchaser.
6. From time to time e-Ochards may wish to collect information of a sensitive personal nature from you. In such cases before e-Ochards asks you for the information it will

inform you of how it intends to use the information and it will ask for your explicit consent.

7. You have the right to ask e-Ochards for a copy of the personal information it holds about you (for which e-Ochards may charge a small fee), and to correct any inaccuracies within that information.
8. When you visit the e-Ochards website, you may be sent a cookie. A cookie is a small file that may be placed on your computer's hard disk for record keeping purposes. It helps e-Ochards to recognize you when you visit the e-Ochards website and make use of the Services so that the information and content of the website can be tailored to your needs. e-Ochards may also use cookies for the compilation of certain statistics relating to the use of the website which do not identify you personally. Such information may include the number of visits, average time spent, web pages accessed, services used and other statistics relating to the website. Where E-Ochards does compile such statistics, it may aggregate these statistics for onward transmission to third parties. These statistics will not include any information by which you will be directly identifiable. You may set your browser to notify you when you receive a cookie, giving you the chance to decide whether or not to accept it. (However, if you decide not to accept a cookie, some web pages might not function properly or you might not be permitted to access certain information in relation to the e-Ochards website or to conduct online transactions).
9. If e-Ochards decides to change its Privacy Policy, it will post such changes on this page so that you are always aware of how e-Ochards uses your personal information and in what circumstances it discloses it.
10. As part of its duties as an ICANN accredited domain name registrar, our Registry Supplier (Easyspace) is required to provide certain information about customers who register domain names with our Registrant Supplier (Easyspace) to the relevant naming authority. This information will include personal data such as the customers name, address and telephone number. The relevant naming authority will make such information available to the public through publicly accessible directories of owners of domain names. If a customer requests that any domain name registered with e-

Orchards shows their own company or personal details, it is a condition of the purchase of a domain name that the customer agrees to the transfer of his/her personal data to the relevant naming authority and agrees to the naming authority making that personal data available on a public database. e-Orchards can provide its customers with details of the relevant naming authority on request.
